

- Plan your safety. As soon as you know of your travel plans and patterns, contact a friend or family member with the information. Upon arriving at your destination, call to let them know you are safe. When possible, make arrangements to travel with others.
- Always make your own travel arrangements. Contact taxicab companies that you are familiar with.
- Be aware. Before stepping into a taxicab, take note of the number on either the front quarter panels or rear truck area.
- When entering a taxicab, check for a photo identification on the dashboard facing the passenger. The driver should match the photo identification. All drivers are required to wear a badge with a number. Listen to your instincts. If you ever feel unsafe leave the vehicle.
- Call 553-1447 with Taxicab complaints.

Remember alcohol and drugs can impair judgment and make you look like an easy target.
